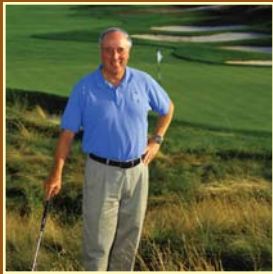

For over forty years, award-winning architect Rees Jones has designed courses that are fair, challenging, continually interesting to play, and visually compelling. Rees Jones' style is based in the rich tradition of Scottish courses and the masterworks of American golf course designers.

Mr. Jones is well known for restoring many of America's greatest courses in preparation for major events: The Country Club for the U.S. Open (1988) and Ryder Cup (1999); Hazeltine National, U.S. Open, 1991; Baltusrol, U.S. Open, 1993; Congressional Blue, U.S. Open, 1997; Pinehurst #2, U.S. Open, 1999; Bethpage Black, U.S. Open, 2002; and Torrey Pines, U.S. Open, 2008.

The golf course at The Golf Club of Cape Cod is a blend of traditional design and innovative style, reminiscent of old New England courses. The layout makes use of the land's natural contours and subtle shifts in elevation. "It's a wonderful finesse course," says Jones.
